October, 2010 Update: Recently, I asked for your prayers and your financial support for my work as the Executive Director of HIM and the International Director of SEED, Inc. for Liberia. I am pleased to announce that so far we received funding or pledges for 30 days for 25% of the need until December 31st. Now we need to cover the remaining 90 days with your help.

Ambassadors: I am inviting you to serve as an Ambassador who will Pray, Provide and Promote the work God has called us to accomplish. If you are already a donor, you are already an Ambassador. We appreciate your prayers and support. I am asking individuals like you to consider covering at least one day of our operating budget until the end of this year. My hope is that each new donor will consider one or more of approximately 120 days at \$100 per day from Sept. 1 – Dec. 31st.

Your financial support will help to keep some major developments moving forward.

BUV Ministry: I am now working on commission-only basis for the BUV Ministry. This is a good deal if we all together can generate some sales of BUVs for use in developing countries. My goal is to sell at least 5 vehicles per month and then get up to 10 per month. Go to www.driveBUV.org for more information. I need your help with this goal. SEED: I agreed to serve as the International Director of Society for Education and Economic Development or SEED, Inc. on a voluntary basis until SEED can raise funding. We are building a more permanent site soon. We have revised our mission and platforms. SEED's mission is to "transform lives and communities in Liberia (West Africa) by training leaders in the marketplace and by developing sustainable community projects".

SEED's Platforms: SEED has two platforms for work in Liberia:

I. EDUCATION (Training in the Marketplace) offering general leadership training, business as mission courses, chaplaincy training, and professional training.

II. ECONOMIC DEVELOPMENT (Building Sustainable Community Projects) focusing on Health; Agriculture, Food & Water Projects; Housing and Shelter Projects; Transportation and Mobility Projects.

Where to Send Your Support: If you prayerfully consider covering at least one day of our ministry budget at \$100 per day, you may send that to our non-profit organization called Healthy Initiative Ministries (HIM) which is focused on some BUV developments in Haiti. Casting the Vision for Haiti: My main ministry is HIM which is working closely with Mission Harvest America in Jacksonville, FL with their work in Haiti. For years, I have been challenged to think of a viable way the BUV Ministry could be developed in Haiti. In the three stages of Relief, Rehabilitation, and Development, it seems that Haiti is proceeding toward the stage of Rehabilitation.

BUV Assembly Plant: To get as many BUVs to Haiti as possible, I have developed the plan for a BUV Assembly Plant to be work in conjunction with Vocational Tech Schools in Haiti. The wood bed set and the rear end clip can be prepared in Haiti while the front end section can be manufactured in the USA and shipped in a crate. Minimal skills are required to connect the main sections with four bolts, driveshaft and brake lines. BUVs assembled in Haiti cut down on the cost of shipping and duties. Jobs are created in an economy that experiences 80% unemployment. Exporting for trade revenues may be possible. That are numerous benefits to this plan. With BUVs made in Haiti, we will have a greater chance of developing several BUV Delivery Service programs that also offer a Business Mission Institute. I am writing the curriculum for the BMIs. The BDS programs need an investment of about \$125k while the Assembly Plant can be launched with minimal investment with progress being dependent on paid orders.

Important – Haiti & Cholera: BUVs are needed in Haiti NOW to carry clean water for the current Cholera Epidemic. The news reports indicate that trucks cannot maneuver to the places where the water is needed in the tent camps. The BUVs can carry as much water as a small truck but can get into small places. PLEASE help us with this project.

New Development with OM International: Also, please pray with me that we will see a working partnering relationship with OM Intl. based in Tyrone, GA. I just sold them a BUV to be sent to Haiti to be used on their new poultry farm. OM is a large organization with 5500 staff in 120 countries. Many know OM by their Ministry Ships called Logos and Doulos. Their site is www.om.org.

The Lively Group (My Tentmaking Work): I am striving to pull my projects and roles under one roof at The Lively Group as Resource and Marketing Consultants. To get this web site, go to www.thelivelygroup.com. To help supplement our support, I am marketing three things:

BUVs, Samaritan Ministries Health Plan, and ageLOC Vitality. Please consider the Samaritan Ministries for a faith-based health plan that really works. The ageLOC Vitality is a new product that offers physical, mental and emotional vitality. We are working to develop a Blue Diamond University with a 20 day Boot Camp to train for internet marketing regardless of the product.

Advance Marriage Life Support (ALMS) : Watch for announcements about the development of a new ministry that is intended to encourage and equip medical residents to help their patients' marriages or help patients prepare for marriage. There is an increasing amount of solid research showing the tremendous impact marriage and divorce have on health. In case you didn't know, our physicians do not get much if any training on ways to prepare or improve marriages. AMLS will be a valuable solution!

Ministry Vehicle Needed: Some of you know that my 1996 Grand Cherokee Jeep caught on fire and completely burned up while driving to Memphis recently. I am in need of a replacement vehicle with a towing package that will haul a trailer with a BUV. Any donated vehicle will help if I can sell or trade them for a vehicle suitable for this need. Don't hesitate if your vehicle is in need of some repairs as I can handle some repairs myself. Many thanks to a couple in our SS Class for a loaner van in the meantime.
